



The Housing Trust of Nova Scotia's (HTNS) mission is to provide good quality, affordable housing for low to moderate-income working households in communities where the cost of housing is skyrocketing or there is a shortage of good, quality rental housing.

HTNS is undergoing rapid growth and increasing impact on households throughout Nova Scotia. We currently own five buildings comprised of 295 units in the Halifax Regional Municipality and are completing \$20M of renovations over the next four years. In 2023 we entered a partnership with Municipal Affairs and Housing to develop \$20M worth of modular housing across Nova Scotia for healthcare professionals.
